



Report: R.I. households expected to grow over next decade, creating more housing demand

PROVIDENCE - A new Rhode Island Housing report said that the number of households in the state will increase by 12 to 13 percent over the next 10 years, creating additional demand for housing. The report, Projecting Future Housing Needs in Rhode Island, was released Wednesday; HousingWorks RI at Roger Williams University was commissioned by Rhode Island Housing to do the report, which said the population is starting to increase after steadily declining from 2006 to 2010.
